



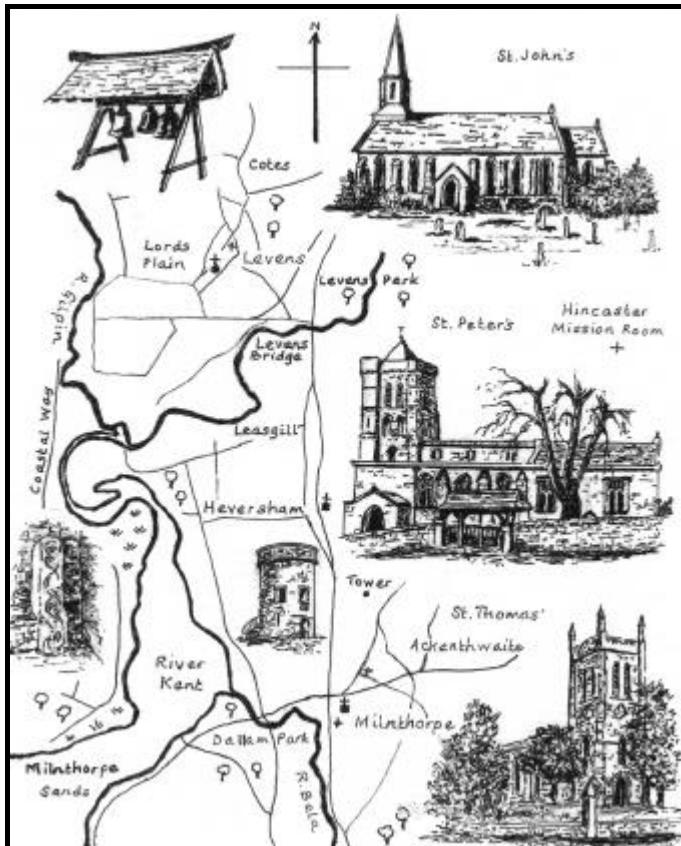

PASTORAL LETTER
from the Reverend Canon Tom Thompson

Dear Friends,

“Summer time, and the livin’ is easy” - so the song goes! But it isn’t, is it? Not when children are on holiday from school, and parents have to juggle with work and making sure the children are safe and occupied. Not everyone can go away on holiday for six weeks – some can’t go away at all! Then what?

Well – it can be a time when parents and children find some space to talk with one another and to listen to each other. How simple is that, but how rarely does it happen – or so it would seem. But it’s vital. Parents have a huge responsibility – that of introducing children to life with all its excitement, its problems, its risks and dangers. And if we don’t introduce them properly, then we’re going to make their lives a burden.

So – listen and talk: about life and all its dimensions. Including the spiritual dimension. That handles questions like “Who am I?” “Where am I from?” “What am I for?” And what questions are harder than these, and need some answers? You could say that they are all “God” questions – and it’s really up to parents to find space to talk with children about them.

If we don’t, we’re letting our children down. Yes, it’s hard, but it’s so very important – and, looking round our present-day society, I believe that it just isn’t being done. And I’m not talking about “Church” – although it might lead to that; I’m talking about the meaning and purpose of living. Don’t forget – it’s “summer time, and the livin’ is easy” - or is it?

May God who gives us all life, and loves us all in it, give you his blessing too!

PRAYER FOR THE NATION

Our congregations are to join in prayers which are being said by groups of Christians across the UK in response to the violence in our cities, the recent decisions in parliament on important moral issues and a general decline of Christian principles governing our national life.

There will be evenings of prayer at The Vicarage in Heversham. The next of these will be on Friday 29th August and prayers for the nation in are being said every month in Milnthorpe – next at the Methodist Chapel on Sunday July 27th from 6.30 pm to 7.15 pm.

All church congregations and villagers are invited to come and listen to the concerns we have for our country at this time and join in times of silent and/or spoken prayer.

Do come and experience Taizé worship at St John's Church, Levens on 31st August at 6.30 pm.

Taizé style worship is flexible and has no real beginning or end. Songs are repeated to help us enter into the contemplation of the presence of God. The simple phrases are easily memorized so that books are not necessary.

We will combine candlelight, silence and Scripture with simple chants to help build awareness of God's presence in ourselves and in our community. As the psalmist wrote:

*“O Lord, my heart is not lifted up,
my eyes are not raised too high;
I do not occupy myself with things too great
and too marvellous for me.
But I have calmed and quieted my soul,
like a child quieted at its mother's breast;
like a child that is quieted is my soul,
O Israel, hope in the Lord from this
time forth and for evermore.”*

OUT OF THE BLUE

As you may know, the Kendal Deanery has been planning this mission for October 2008

As for Walk Cumbria, various events have been planned and most will be attended by Bishop James.

A copy of the draft programme is now displayed in St Peter's and St Thomas'. All the events in our area are for all KE congregations and their friends, and people from the whole deanery are especially invited to the two main Sunday evening services, in Kendal on the 5th and in Kirkby Lonsdale on the 12th October.

We are also planning another KE walk to Kendal for the pre-mission meeting on Saturday 4th with Bishop James in Abbot Hall park. This is likely to start from Levens Bridge and walk up beside the river Kent, perhaps returning, for those who wish to walk both ways, along the route of the Lancaster canal. More about that in September.

Part two of the Mission Support evenings at 7.30 pm will be held on Monday 15th September at St Mary's Primary School, Kirkby Lonsdale, and repeated at Burneside Church meeting room on Tuesday September 23rd.

We hope that several people from each of our parishes will have attended the Part 1 session in June and will go to a Part 2 evening in September.

All parishes now have Out of the Blue prayer cards, which will be distributed in the coming weeks.

VISIT TO UKRAINE IN MAY

Last month I spent ten days in Ukraine working with "Kolo Sertcya", the group who will be coming to England in November. They are a delightful bunch of lively young people and their teacher, Lena Bilashenko, does a brilliant job. They will be performing at forty venues during their 4week tour (at Kendal's Strickland Gate Methodist Church on Friday 21 November - please NB!) and the object of their tour is to raise money for HOPE NOW's work in Ukraine.

A major part of this work is helping street children and orphans - of whom, sadly, there are far too many in Ukraine. Besides improving the facilities in Orphanages, HOPE NOW arrange for children to be fostered in Christian homes, and it was a joy to visit three such homes while I was there. The way the foster-parents accept and love the children entrusted to them, and treat them just as if they were their own, is truly wonderful. Also humbling. And it is also wonderful to see how the orphaned children - most of whom have experienced appalling abuse and neglect in their earliest years - grow and thrive in the environment of a loving, caring family. Do, please, pray for this work. Also for Kolo Sertcya as they prepare during the next few months for what we hope will be a very successful tour.

Saint Thomas' Church: Milnthorpe



Milnthorpe Cemetery

Early in the 20th century, the land known as Milnthorpe Cemetery was conveyed to St. Thomas' church as an extension of its churchyard, for the purpose of being set apart for Christian burial. This means that the land belongs to St. Thomas' Church and is not a public cemetery, like the one at Lancaster crematorium. Consequently, although any resident of Milnthorpe who wishes to, may be buried there with the permission of the church, all burials are subject to the national and diocesan regulations for churchyards belonging to Anglican, (Church of England) Churches.

It is very difficult, in a period when those whose loved ones have died and when grief is still raw, to have to make decisions about memorials etc. To make it easier, all the local stonemasons are fully aware of the diocesan regulations concerning the size of headstones which may be permitted and the material of which they are made and will help people in their decision making.

The churchyard regulations in the Carlisle diocese are very specific and do have to be adhered to. Apart from headstones, no other memorials, artificial flowers or plastic decorations are allowed to be placed on graves.

If you can help us to keep the cemetery looking cared for, by placing fresh flowers only on graves, we would be very grateful.



At the June meeting of Milnthorpe-with-Heversham Mothers Union,

the service opened with the hymn "For the beauty of the Earth" followed by a Bible reading "Jesus blesses the children".

Mrs Susan Bailey, wife of the Vicar of Cartmel, was welcomed to speak on "Ministry to the Under 5s and their families". She emphasised the importance for a "child friendly" church and welcoming the parents. She described how Carlisle Diocesan Mothers Union supports with resources the planning of new Toddler Groups, pram services, Sunday creches, Mums and Tots and more. (We did tell her of our own Buzz Club and Sunday Circle). Mrs Bailey demonstrated activities possible for children to enjoy the stories of Jesus, and the Old Testament using toy figures, cuddly animals, colourful books.

She also spoke of welcoming the many people and all children present at a Baptism Service.

Secretary Jane Clarke expressed appreciative thanks to Mrs Bailey.

We were reminded of the Deanery Coffee morning on July 5th at Kirkland Hall Kendal, and for donations of cakes etc for the stalls there. Those unable to attend may leave any gifts on Friday 4th July at St Thomas' Church Centre with Joan Ellam.

Heversham Churchyard - Footpath

The footpath that runs through the churchyard had been cleared of mud and resurfaced. I hope it will now be much easier to walk through the churchyard in bad weather. It has been quite expensive to resurface this path and we would request that people walking through the churchyard stay on the path and keep dogs on leads, to avoid the chippings being spread over a wider area.

The churchyard is consecrated ground and I am sure, that like me, you would like to keep it as a place that is treated with respect and that in walking through and enjoying its peace, we do not encroach on ground where people are buried.

We have tried to enhance the upper churchyard on Woodhouse Lane by resurfacing the entrance, to make it more easily accessible in bad weather and have also repaired and repainted the gates. As with all churchyards in this diocese, apart from headstones, no other memorials, artificial flowers or plastic decorations are allowed to be placed on graves. If you can help us to keep the churchyard looking cared for, by placing fresh flowers only on graves, we would be very grateful

The June meeting of St Peter's PCC

was the first one since the annual meeting in April. We began by sharing communion together. Three new, elected members were welcomed: Beth Taylor, Liz Fawcett and Tony Hesmondhalgh and also two new ex-officio members who join the PCC because of their appointment as Churchwarden (Sue Tallis) and Deanery Synod representative (Annie Garden).

One of the first things that the new PCC did was to agree to better communicate PCC business. As a result, the minutes of each meeting will be displayed in the Dallam Chapel and there will be a brief report in the Parish News.

Treasurer, Mike Robinson reported that the Gift Day had raised £8,700, including Gift aid tax recovery. Sue Wilson reported that Brian Sedgwick had left a most generous bequest of £20,000 for St Peter's. It was agreed to meet his request for a seat to be installed in the Churchyard and for the bulk of the money to be held for the planned installation of an audio-visual system and for improvements to the lighting.

There was further discussion about the new "Parish Share" process through which churches contribute to the cost of ministry in the Diocese and also about the development of the Kent Estuary Group. We heard details about the forthcoming Parish Weekend and discussed plans for future services and other events. We also had updates on the fabric of the Church (including reassuring news about the electrics) and ongoing work in the Churchyard, with George Handley reporting on the generous donation of a new flag pole and flag from Robin Sissons and Ron Gerrard respectively.

We ended with a discussion about how the Ministry team can best get feedback from the congregation about how people experience different services, recognising that the congregation includes people with a wide range of preferred styles of worship. We meet again at the beginning of August.

### The natural world

#### Hincaster Trailway Group

The railway line from Hincaster to Arnside was originally in use from 1876 until 1942 and, like many small lines, was rarely economic. The rails were removed in 1966.

**However, old railway lines can have a new lease of life and lend themselves particularly well to safe traffic free routes for use on foot, cycle or horseback with full disabled access.**

The Hincaster Trailway Group is a community based support group, which hopes to see the old branch line developed into a local resource and maintained in perpetuity.

Pupils from Dallam School would be involved in the project and the already wide range of wildlife and plants would be conserved and enhanced by careful management.

The route would provide new opportunities for exercise, with the associated health benefits and improved quality of life.

The Trailway would provide an accessible quiet haven for the enjoyment of the countryside bringing together examples of local ecology and landscape, and meeting the needs of wildlife while encouraging public access.

#### Book Review

If you like a good read and an easy read but with a real challenge I recommend “**Out of the Black Shadows.**” By Stephen Lungu.

Stephen grew up unwanted and unloved in Rhodesia, now Zimbabwe. Abandoned by his mother together with his brother and sister in the middle of the town, life was cruel living with an Aunt who had no time or love for him. She often made him live in the hencoop. Eventually he ran away and lived rough. To prevent starvation he scavenged rotting food from dustbins in the more affluent part of town. Camaraderie was found as a member of a gang The Black Shadows of which he became leader.

His life was turned round quite as dramatically as St Paul's. Going to a tent meeting to blow it up he instead found Jesus. Life struggles didn't cease but the purpose changed dramatically. He immediately started to share the Good News of Jesus on the buses. Given money for a Bible he went to a shoe shop, the only place he knew where they sold leather goods and Bibles had leather covers! God's provision and challenge as learned love and acceptance from white people as part of God's family, meeting two elderly ladies who 30 years before had prayed for a gang leader to come to know Jesus on the very night of that tent meeting. A story of rejection, love, care, understanding and above all faith, his faith in God and other peoples faith in him as he travelled the long journey from gang leader to evangelist.
