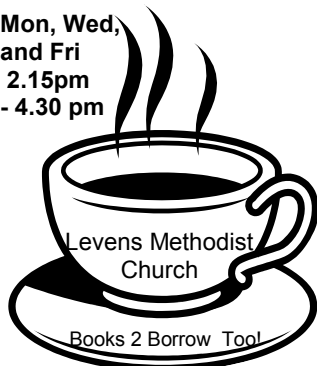

Dear Friends,

It's just six weeks or so since we celebrated Easter. I wonder what's been going on in your lives since Easter Day? In these six weeks 2000 years ago, the lives of the first disciples were turned upside down. They had seen Jesus, the one they had given up everything to follow, arrested, brutally murdered and miraculously brought back to life. They had talked with him, eaten with him, listened to him and probably thought – 'Great, we can carry on now Jesus is back, just like we were before all that happened!'

But Jesus was different. His hands and feet bore the marks of all He had been through – He had been to hell and back – literally - and alive again, He was seen by many of his followers. Then just a week ago, they had seen Jesus leave them, taken up into heaven before their eyes. Now, six weeks after seeing Jesus alive again, He's not with them any more. Whatever next!

Well, huddled together in an upstairs room, something happened – something almost too wonderful to describe. The breath of God which had brought Jesus back from the dead, was filling his disciples, transforming them from being people who were too frightened to speak publicly in case they too were arrested and killed, to having the courage, the power and God's words, telling everyone about what had happened that first Easter and since and what it all meant.

But this wasn't just for then. It's still happening now!

God's Spirit gives life to the whole of Creation, our own lives and that of the creatures that share the world with us.

This year, recognising that we have the privilege of living in an incredibly beautiful part of God's world, we want to celebrate together the wonders of Morecambe Bay during a special week of celebration. Every community between Fleetwood and Barrow is involved in sharing, and what else could we share from here, but loaves and fishes – just like Jesus did with his first followers after his death.

As part of '*Loaves and Fishes around the Bay*,' St. Thomas' Church are holding an outdoor BBQ for all - bread and fish of course – on The Green at 5pm on the 8th June, Pentecost Sunday.

Do join us – we'd love to share this celebration. See you there!

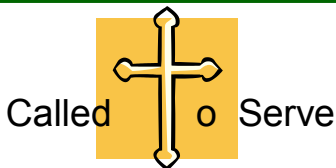

St John's Levens PCC meeting

At a recent meeting of the PCC Jean Hayton was welcomed as a brand new member of the council. Holy Communion was shared using an Iona Liturgy. Revd Ruth reported that the Vicarage was to have some upgrading with a new kitchen and utility and a new shower room. The architect was producing two specification documents; one for the renewing of the church roof and one regarding the re-pointing of the south wall of the church. He would send these for tender, in each case to 3 different professionals and we hope to have a response by the end of May. With regards to this the PCC agreed to look at a new heating system so the church building would be 'watertight and warm'. Some finances were to be drawn from investments towards the cost of the repairs, grants are to be applied for and a small group will look at the producing of a fundraising leaflet to be delivered in the village. Looking back 'Experience Easter Outside' had been appreciated by many including the school. Thanks to Pam Martin for taking the initiative. Chris Band and Revd Ruth are to invite all those involved in organising social activities to a meeting to discuss what to plan for the future. Monthly Edward Bear club for families with babies and toddlers has got off to a good start and the Young People want to raise some money for Hope Now with a 'dressing up walk'.

Cornwall – especially Portleven – the sound of the waves pounding the beach is wonderful.

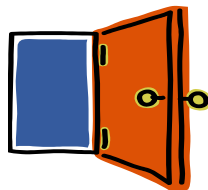

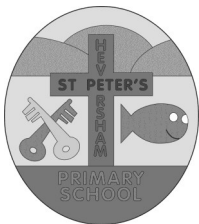

From April, Bailiffs have to follow new rules & processes when collecting debts.



The main changes include:

- Banning bailiffs from visiting at night
- Stopping bailiffs from entering a home when only a child is present
- Preventing bailiffs taking necessary household items, eg. cooker or washing machine
- Providing greater protection from bailiff action for vulnerable people
- Making sure at least 7 days' notice of bailiff action is given and 7 days' notice before selling any belongings
- Compulsory training and certification for bailiffs
- A simplified fee structure, including set fees for each stage of bailiff action
- A responsibility to provide information at all stages of the process, with notices containing wording that is set out by law
- Distress for rent arrears has also been abolished, meaning that land lords can no longer use bailiffs to collect residential rent arrears

Citizens Advice will be monitoring the action of local Bailiff to ensure they abide by the new rules. If you're in debt, don't panic. **Remember it is never too late to get help.** **Free, confidential advice and help is available from Cumbria Rural Citizens Advice Bureau on any aspect of debt, consumer problems, benefits, housing, employment and any other problems. Dallam Swimming Club – pool reopening update

As some parents and new residents have told us they are keen to see the pool and hear more about the plans the committee will have a presence on June 21st at the village sports – the pool is in the sports hall adjacent to the playing field where the sports are held.

First lottery bid not successful: but re applying with the support of Dallam School Dallam Swimming Club have been encouraged to re apply for a grant for the pool and led to hope that with adjustments the bid would be successful next time.

Our thanks to Dallam School

Mr Bancroft and Mrs Hamer have not only arranged the offer of a lease but have agreed to take responsibility for maintenance and pool chemicals in return for the boarders' use of the pool. This makes the project much more affordable. We only got this news after submitting the first bid and it would much enhance the project viability.

Thanks to Mr Bancroft for his optimism, generosity and support .

The grant is to repair the pool and install affordable heating systems to reduce heating costs from £5,600 annually to around £2000. The plan is to continue with family swimming hours similar to our previous ones but add a great deal more including aquacise classes, lifesaving training and swimming lessons for all ages who want to improve their swimming style.

The pool has brought enormous happiness to the village over the years and we really want to see it continue as a community focus.

The school are also bidding to re open the Pavilion on Tristrams and we urge your support for this too.
